

Dear Mr. Picente:

Plaintiff Madeline LaRou having commenced action in New York State Supreme Court against Oneida County for alleged injuries sustained on December 4, 2010 at a Christmas Tree Lighting/Fireworks display in Rome, NY. The fireworks frightened horses that were controlled by the County. Plaintiff sustained numerous injuries, including a permanent injury which will require corrective surgery when she reaches full growth at approximately 16 years of age.

I am in receipt of letters from attorney Bartle J. Gorman, counsel for Oneida County and Gus Boucher, Claims Administrator for Oneida County, recommending that the above referenced matter be settled by all parties for the total amount of \$65,000, with a County share in the amount of \$32,500. I agree with the recommendation of settlement and I ask that this matter be referred to the Board of Legislators for their approval at their December 11, 2013 regular session.

Capital Project HG479 – North Utica Parallel Interceptor

Dear County Executive Picente:

Bids were recently opened for the North Utica Parallel Interceptor Project. Unfortunately, bids came in significantly over the engineer's estimate. Consequently, an additional \$2,000,000 is need to complete the project and will have to be funded by bonding.

Article 5-A, Section 268 of the County Law requires, among other things, that a public hearing be held by the Board of Legislators to consider the improvements that will be made by the capital project in question. This public hearing is required before the Board can consider a bonding resolution for the project. The Board must pass the attached resolution establishing the public hearing to continue the funding process.

The financial consultants have calculated the new estimated cost of the project for the average single family residence to be approximately \$4.35 and \$6.52 for a two-family residence for the first year.

I would appreciate consideration of this request by you and Board of Legislators so that the legislation could be acted upon during the December 11th meeting. This would allow the public hearing to be held prior to the board meeting on December 26th.

I am available to meet with you or the Board at your convenience to discuss this request and explain the change in the project in more detail.

A RESOLUTION CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING A PROPOSED INCREASE IN COST OF IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE ONEIDA COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the County Legislature has duly approved and authorized expenses in improvements to the Oneida County Sewer District consisting of North Utica Interceptor improvements at a maximum estimated cost of \$11,630,000; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Water Quality and Water Pollution Control of the County has requested an increase in the estimated maximum cost of such project by \$2,000,000 to \$13,630,000; and

WHEREAS, it has been proposed that the additional \$2,000,000 will be financed by the issuance of bonds; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a public hearing thereon; NOW, THEREFORE, BE ITRESOLVED, by the County Legislature of the County of Oneida, New York, as follows:

Section 1. A meeting of the County Legislature, the County of Oneida, New York, to be held at the County Office Building, in Utica, New York, in said County, on the 26th day of December, 2013, at 1:45 o'clock P.M., prevailing time, for the purpose of conducting a Public Hearing upon the aforesaid matter.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Legislature is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of the Notice of Public Hearing hereinafter provided to be published once in the official newspaper not less than ten, nor more than twenty, days before the date designated for the hearing.
