Tallarino v. Oneida County Board of Legislators and Oneida County

Dear Chairman Fiorini:

With regard to the lawsuit brought against the Oneida County Legislature and Oneida County by Oneida County Legislator Frank D. Tallarino, Legislative District 12, I believe the members of the County Attorney's office have a conflict of interest and outside counsel needs to be retained to defend this suit.

Pursuant to both the County Charter and the County Administrative Code, the County Attorney represents the Board of Legislators. Specifically, the Administrative Code provides that the County Attorney shall represent the Board of Legislators in any action brought against the County Legislature, including suits by "any county officer or employee." Administrative Code of Oneida County, Section 1502 (a) (emphasis added).

The suit brought by Mr. Tallarino presents a circumstance that I believe provides an exception to the provisions of Section 1502 (a). Mr. Tallarino has sued this action both individually, in his capacity as a County Legislator, and as Minority Leader of the Board of Legislators. The suit constitutes a legislator versus legislator legal action. As the attorney for the entire Board of Legislators, the County Attorney's office faces a conflict of interest with the prospect of representing some of the Board in an action brought by other Board members.

Section 202 (n) of the County Charter authorizes the County Legislature to employ legal advisers as deemed necessary.

Accordingly, I am hereby requesting that the Oneida County Legislature engage outside counsel to defend this lawsuit.

If you should desire to discuss any of the issues raised in this letter, or if you should require anything further of me, please advise.

- WHEREAS, On April 9, 2014 Frank Tallarino, Oneida County Legislator, Legislative District 12, did commence a legal proceeding against the Oneida County Board of Legislators and the County of Oneida by service of a Summons and Complaint and Notice of Petition and Petition, and
- WHEREAS, The Charter for the County of Oneida and the Administrative Code for the County of Oneida both provide that the County Attorney shall defend the Board of Legislators in all civil actions and proceedings, and
- WHEREAS, The County Attorney has provided the Board of Legislators with an opinion that the proceeding commenced by Legislator Tallarino presents a conflict of interest for the County Attorney and therefore constitutes an exception to the provisions of the County Charter and Administrative Code pertaining to the defense of the Board of Legislators in civil actions and proceedings by the County Attorney, and
- WHEREAS, In accordance with Section 202 of the Oneida County Charter, the Oneida County Board of Legislators is empowered to employ legal advisers as may be necessary, now, therefore, be it hereby
- RESOLVED, That Herbert J. Cully, Esq., is retained as counsel to Oneida County in the matter of "Frank Tallarino Individually and as Minority Leader Of the Oneida County Board of Legislators, Plaintiff, vs. The Oneida County Board of Legislators and the County of Oneida, Defendants", to be compensated at a rate of Two Hundred and 00/100ths Dollars per hour (\$200.00/hr.) with a total amount fees and disbursements not to exceed Ten Thousand and 00/100ths Dollars (\$10,000.00) without further authorization of this Board.
