The settlement calls for a payment of \$900,000 from Oneida County for extra work and \$350,000 from the engineers that were involved in the project. It is proposed to fund the County portion of the settlement from Department fund balance. No further bonding will be conducted for the project. In order to complete this capital project which is crucial to the building of the NANO Center and other development on the north side of the Mohawk River, it will be necessary to amend the current capital project.

I am requesting authority to assign the remainder of the County's Self-Insured Retention in the matter of Christina Dye, Administratrix of the Estate of Joseph M. Quayle, Deceased, vs. Oneida County, New York, Oneida County Sheriff, Oneida County Correctional Facility and Correctional Medical Care, Inc. to our carrier, Tokio Marine HCC Public Risk Claims Service.

This matter involves a claim arising out of an incident which occurred on September 13, 2014. The Claimant, Christina Dye, Administratrix of the Estate of Joseph M. Quayle, Deceased, alleges that decedent's death was caused by negligent conduct at the Oneida County Correctional Facility while decedent was incarcerated.

It is the opinion of the insurance adjusters, our claims administrator and our attorney, David Bagley, Esq., that this claim will not be settled within the County's Self-Insured Retention of \$100,000.00. We have been asked by our insurance carrier, Tokio Marine HCC Public Risk Claims Service, to assign the remainder of the Retention to Tokio Marine HCC Public Risk Claims Service.

I recommend and request that the Board of Legislators authorize an assignment of the Retention

of this claim to Tokio Marine HCC Public Risk Claims Service.

Honorable Members:

In order to close the County accounting records for 2015, the need for fund transfers appeared in various departmental appropriation accounts throughout the County. These transfers are required primarily due to the need to charge 2015 accounts for actual and anticipated 2015 expenditures occurring in 2016, as required under Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).

The transfers are fully covered by surplus funds in the 2015 budgets of other related accounts and will not require the use of funds from the Fund Balance. In most cases, the following transfers are made from unencumbered funds in other appropriation accounts within the respective departments.

Several accounts were known to be running high during 2015, but the exact magnitude of the deficit was not known until GAAP charges were computed in January, February and March, 2016. GAAP rules also require us to recognize gross sales tax revenues and record amounts that are shared with the cities and towns in the County.

Therefore, in accordance with Section 610, Oneida County Administrative Code, I hereby request your Board approval for the following 2015 fund transfers. I also request that these closeouts be acted on at the June 8, 2016 meeting.

As you and I have discussed, the State of New York is going to improve the roadway through the Griffiss Business Park in Rome, New York.
