RESOLUTION NO.

INTRODUCED BY: Messrs. 2<sup>ND</sup> BY: Mr.

RE: IMPOSING THE WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS SURCHARGES PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF TAX LAW § 186-g

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of Oneida, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Imposition of wireless communications surcharges. (a) Pursuant to the authority of Tax Law § 186-g, there are hereby imposed and there shall be paid surcharges within the territorial limits of the County of Oneida on: (i) wireless communications service provided to a wireless communications customer with a place of primary use within such County, at the rate of thirty cents per month on each wireless communications device in service during any part of the month; and (ii) the retail sale of prepaid wireless communications service sold within such County, at the rate of thirty cents per retail sale, whether or not any tangible personal property is sold therewith.
  - (b) Wireless communications service suppliers shall begin to add such surcharge to the billings of its customers and prepaid wireless communications sellers shall begin to collect such surcharge from its customers commencing December 1, 2017.
  - (c) Each wireless communications service supplier and prepaid wireless communications seller is entitled to retain, as an administrative fee, an amount equal to three percent of its collections of the surcharges imposed by this Resolution, provided that the supplier or seller files any required return and remits the surcharges due to the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance on or before the due date for that return and that payment.
- **SECTION 2.** Administration of surcharges. The surcharges imposed by this Resolution shall be administered and collected by the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance as provided in paragraph (8) of Tax Law § 186-g, and in a like manner as the taxes imposed by Articles Twenty-eight and Twenty-nine of the Tax Law.
- **SECTION 3.** Applicability of State law to surcharges imposed by this Resolution. All the provisions of Tax Law § 186-g shall apply to the surcharges imposed by this Resolution with the same force and effect as if those provisions had been set forth in full in this Resolution, except to the extent that any of those provisions is either inconsistent with or not relevant to the surcharges imposed by this Resolution.
- SECTION 4. Net collections received by this County from the surcharges imposed by this Resolution shall be expended only upon authorization of the Board of Legislators of the County of Oneida and only for payment of system costs, eligible wireless 911 service costs, or other costs associated with the administration, design, installation, construction, operation, or maintenance of public safety communications networks or a system to provide enhanced wireless 911 service serving such County, as provided in paragraph (9) of Tax Law § 186-g, including, but not limited to,

hardware, software, consultants, financing and other acquisition costs. The County shall separately account for and keep adequate books and records of the amount and object or purpose of all expenditures of all such monies. If, at the end of any fiscal year, the total amount of all such monies exceeds the amount necessary for payment of the above mentioned costs in such fiscal year, such excess shall be reserved and carried over for the payment of those costs in the following fiscal year.

**SECTION 5.** Effective date. This Resolution shall take effect December 1, 2017.

CMOM Program Implementation-Phase 5 WAYS & MEAN

Dear County Executive Picente:

On March 29, 2013 the Master Agreement to provide engineering services for compliance with the consent order issued by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) and for resolving permit issues affecting the Oneida County Water Pollution Control Plant between Oneida County and Shumaker Consulting Engineering and Land Surveying, PC was assigned to GHD Consulting Services, Inc. The Master Agreement calls for the submission of work orders with associated pricing for specific tasks that are needed as the project develops.

GHD has submitted for consideration Work Order #27, Amendment 4 which would cover Phase 5 of the implementation of a district-wide Capacity Management, Operations and Maintenance Program (CMOM). Implementing this program in the Sauquoit Creek Pumping Station service area is a requirement of the current NYSDEC consent order. Furthermore, the program is being implemented district-wide due to concerns over capacity at the Oneida County Water Pollution Control Plant.

Department staff has reviewed this work order and its scope of work and find it acceptable. It is recommended that this work order be accepted with an estimated cost of \$217,300. Funding for this work order will come from the Department 2017 operating budget as the program is being implemented district-wide. It should be noted that the price has increased from last year due to the addition of an expanded Task 6-Incinerator Sewer Maintenance Program.



#### Honorable Members:

In order to close the County accounting records for 2016, the need for fund transfers appeared in various departmental appropriation accounts throughout the County. These transfers are required primarily due to the need to charge 2016 accounts for actual and anticipated 2016 expenditures occurring in 2017, as required under Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).

The transfers are fully covered by surplus funds in the 2016 budgets of other related accounts and will not require the use of funds from the Fund Balance. In most cases, the following transfers are made from unencumbered funds in other appropriation accounts within the respective departments.

Several accounts were known to be running high during 2016, but the exact magnitude of the deficit was not known until GAAP charges were computed in January, February and March, 2017. GAAP rules also require us to recognize gross sales tax revenues and record amounts that are shared with the cities and towns in the County.

Therefore, in accordance with Section 610, Oneida County Administrative Code, I hereby request your Board approval for the following <u>2016</u> fund transfers. I also request that these closeouts be acted on at the **June 14, 2017** meeting.



It was a pleasure speaking with you today regarding the property located at 2230 Oneida Street in Clayville. This property collapsed several years ago, and all attempts to get the owner to clean it up have failed. On September 8, 2016, the village secured a court order from Oneida County Supreme Court to allow us (the village) to raze the structure and subsequently pursue the owner, Mr. Ryan Quinn, for costs of the removal.

This structure is much more than an eyesore, it is a hazard to the health and safety of the public and the building needs to be razed. We are opening bids this Thursday, May 18, 2017, for the demolition. We are expecting bids to come in around the \$50,000.00 to \$90,000.00 range.

Additionally, I have submitted, and have been thus far approved, for a \$50,000.00 Dormitory Authority of New York State (DASNY) grant through Senator Joseph Griffo. This grant may be used for the repayment of the bond the village is securing to pay for the demolition, or may be used for the construction of a 'passive park' at this location. Currently, the rules for the grant appear to limit the use of the monies for property that the village owns in regards to repayment of the bonds the village is securing.

I currently have preliminary plans drawn-up for the design and layout for a passive park at this location. The park plan includes benches, trees and shrubs, tables and a pergola, a parking area and access to the Sauquoit Creek for fishing.

Currently this property is in very serious default on the property taxes, and I am requesting that the County of Oneida take this property and convey it to the Village of Clayville for the public good. I would respectfully request that this action be handled as quickly as possible as it would go a long way to finalize the approval of the grant, and would facilitate the removal of a public hazard in the village.
