Dear Chairman Fiorini:

On September 11, 2019, your Board approved the purchase of 417 – 421 Main Street in the City of Utica with the passing of Resolution Number 284. This building was purchased in effort to clean up the area in front of the Rail Express Agency (REA) Wing at Union Station and to provide additional parking for the Oneida County Public Market.

The purchase is in the final stages and it is now necessary to prepare for the demolition of the property and make the additional parking for the Oneida County Public Market. The building has been deemed not structurally sound by engineers and is in the process of being condemned by the City of Utica. The building has to come down and it is necessary to create a Capital Project to account for the demolition cost and the State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) which is required by New York State.

I therefore request your Board's approval for the following:

A.) Establishment of Capital Project H-594 - DPW - Demolition of the Brown Building

B.) Funding for Capital Project H – 594 as follows:
