Dear County Executive Picente:

In a continuing effort to assist businesses throughout Oneida County, we are proposing to apply for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding made available by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR) through their 2020 Economic Development Program.

Based on the requirements from the OCR, Oneida County will apply for an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for Dan Hudon Sales, Inc. located in the Town of Trenton. This funding will assist the company with the purchase of machinery/equipment to become more efficient and cost effective in their production processes, allowing the company to explore new product offerings within its manufacturing operation. This project will create 4 new jobs at the Barneveld facility.

Since the CDBG program does not require a local match, no Oneida County dollars will be expended on these projects. Upon award of the CDBG grant, Mohawk Valley EDGE will administer the program on behalf of Oneida County.

Therefore, we respectfully request that you submit to the Oneida County Board of Legislators a request to authorize you to submit an application to the New York State Office of Community Renewal for an Economic Development grant totaling \$60,000. Included in this resolution is the schedule to conduct the mandated public hearings on the Community Development Block Grant application, as required by the statutory requirements of the CDBG program, and, if awarded the grant, authorization to enter into an agreement with the Mohawk Valley EDGE to administer the program.

WHEREAS, Oneida County Executive Anthony J. Picente, Jr., is in receipt of correspondence from James J. Genovese II, Commissioner of Planning, requesting submittal of an application by Oneida County to the State of New York Office of Community Renewal (OCR) for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) direct grants totaling \$60,000, and

WHEREAS, The CDBG program requires the holding of two public hearings by the County, a minimum of one prior to the submission of said application to obtain the views of citizens regarding the proposed application, and one following the award to report on project accomplishments, and

WHEREAS, The CDBG program requires that the Community Development Block Grant application must comply with the program requirements set forth in 2 CFR Part 200 and applicable subparts and 24 CFR Part 570, as amended, now, therefore, be it hereby

The enclosed contract amendment procures construction phase engineering services needed for reconstruction of the Marcy-SUNY IT Parkway in the Town of Marcy. Project limits begin at the Northerly roundabout entrance to the Cree project site and extend Northerly to Mulaney Road.

On February 5, 2020, the Oneida County Board of Acquisition & Contract accepted a proposal from Lochner Engineering, P.C. in the amount of \$490,000.00 to prepare plans and specifications for reconstruction of the Marcy-SUNY IT Parkway.

In order for Cree to meet its expected production schedule it is crucial to initiate construction as soon as possible. Therefore, an initial agreement for consulting services in the amount of \$48,839.00 was executed. The initial scope of work was sufficient to begin right-of-way acquisition, survey and mapping, and preliminary design. A contract amendment for the balance of consulting services in the amount of \$441,161.00 must now be executed for the construction phase of the project. Funding will be provided thru Capital Project H-618. The term of the amendment begins upon execution and ends December 31, 2021.

Please review the enclosed contract and if acceptable forward to the Oneida County Board of Legislators for consideration.

Honorable Members:

In an effort to try to control the financial hemorrhaging due to Covid-19, all Department Heads and all Elected Officials were asked to propose cuts to their current 2020 budget. Below please find proposed cuts as submitted or as viewed as possible by the Budget Office. These cuts will be put in a contingency account established to track proposed savings, and be available if necessary later on in the budget year. I would also like to point out that the following cuts also equate to approximately a loss of \$770,468 in revenue.

I have also asked the various departments to reduce the number of take home vehicles. In the beginning of April, there were 76 vehicles taken home. All departments reporting directly to my office made adjustments and currently the County has 58 vehicles taken home. The Sheriff's and District Attorney's Offices total 48 of that number.

I ask the attached transfers be acted upon at the May 13th meeting. I therefore request your Board approval for the following attached <u>2020</u> fund transfers:


