Dear Mr. Picente:

I am submitting the attached Amended Resolution for your review and approval.

The original resolution (Resolution no. 329, December 21, 2021) approved a contract template with a termination date of March 20, 2022. Since the execution of the original agreements, the New York State Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) has extended the deadline to use program funds. The Amended Resolution will extend the term of agreements until June 30, 2022.

The agreements are funded by the OCFS Safe Summer Youth Engagement program, which aims to support positive youth development activities administered through OCFS. Safe Summer Youth Engagement funds are to be utilized for targeted intervention, prevention, and jobs to engage at-risk youth and get young people off the streets in the communities most impacted by gun violence. Oneida County has been allocated \$250,000 to support such programs.
