RE: APPROVAL OF FEDERAL AID AND STATE AID AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND NYSDOT FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF JUDD ROAD, PHASE I

- WHEREAS, A Project for the Judd Road (County Route 40); Halsey Road to Interstate 90, Town of Whitestown, Oneida County, P.I.N. 2754.21 (the "Project") is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal funds, and
- WHEREAS, The County of Oneida desires to advance the above Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-Federal share of the total Project cost if Marchiselli funding (State Aid) is not made available in the NYS 2009-2010 Budget, now, therefore, be it hereby
- **RESOLVED,** That the Board of Legislators authorizes the County of Oneida to pay in the first instance 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the cost of the Project or portions thereof to be borne as follows:

- **RESOLVED,** That in the event the full Federal and non-Federal share of the Project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the Board of Legislators shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the Department thereof, and it is further
- RESOLVED, That Oneida County Executive Anthony J. Picente, Jr., is hereby authorized to execute all necessary Agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid and/or Marchiselli Aid on behalf of the County of Oneida with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of the Federal-aid and State-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible, and it is further

RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary Agreement in connection with the Project.
