Up to 50% of the total cost to be covered with Federal Transit Administration funding, 40% with NYS Department of Transportation funding and the 10% local share provided by Birnie Bus Tour, Inc.. There is no cost to the County of Oneida.

WHEREAS: In the death of Clifford L. Kotary, on Monday, December 27, 2010, the family of the deceased, the Town of Floyd, and the County of Oneida have lost a valued citizen, whose contributions were many and who held the respect and esteem of the citizens of Oneida County, and

WHEREAS: Most notably Clifford L. Kotary served his community for over fifty years as an elected official as a Floyd Town Councilman, Town Supervisor, Highway Superintendent, Fire Department Commissioner and Welfare Officer in the Town of Floyd. Clifford L. Kotary served on the Oneida County Board of Supervisors from 1962 through 1968 and was Chairman of the Oneida County Board of Supervisor from 1966 through 1967, prior to the change of the Board to the current body as the Board of Legislators, and

WHEREAS: Clifford L. Kotary was a recipient of the New York State Senate Liberty Metal for lifetime achievement. Mr. Kotary also had a legendary hall of fame racing career as a stock car driver. He won more than 300 races during his career. He was also an avid outdoorsman, and

WHEREAS: Clifford L. (Cliff) Kotary appreciated those things in life that were important and will be remembered as a devoted husband, father, grandfather to his beloved family and as a most distinguished public servant, and be it hereby

RESOLVED: That the members of this Board of Legislators, speaking for the citizens of our respective communities, extend to the family of the late Clifford L. Kotary our sincere sympathy, our appreciation for the value of his services to the County of Oneida, and our respect for his worth as a man.
