FIRE OFFICER II (NFPA 1021-2020 EDITION) (01-11-0014) - 076

Description:

Meeting the job performance requirements found in Chapter 5 of NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications, the Fire Officer II course builds on the skills learned in Fire Officer I.

Additionally, students begin to examine the functions of a “Managing Fire Officer”. Topics include government administration, human resources management, media relations, budgeting and purchasing, origin and cause investigations, conducting accident investigations, analyzing agency data, post-incident analysis, and the development of an incident action plan for a multi-unit response.

Note: This course provides little to no discussion of strategy and tactics. The Fire Officer II course includes the Fire Officer II National Certification examination as the course final exam.
