

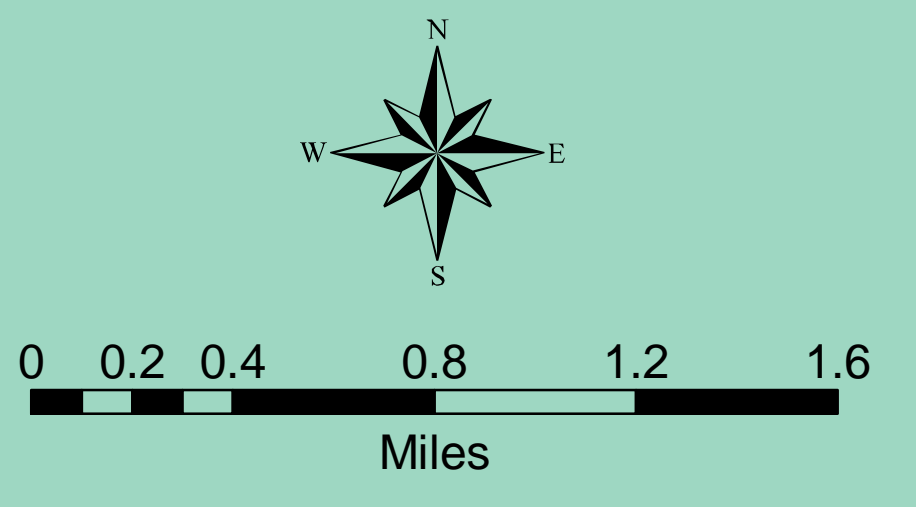
The Sauquoit Creek Steering Committee took a Bus Tour of the Sauquoit Creek Basin as shown on this map on September 19, 2002.

- The purpose of the trip was to get a sense of the following
- size of the Basin
  - the land types within the Basin
  - the variety of topography within the Basin
  - the variety of land uses within the Basin
  - population densities
  - changing amounts of impervious surfaces within the Basin
  - the character of the stream and its tributaries
  - various uses of the stream
  - changing water quality at various locations along the stream
  - various attempts to control flooding
  - various impediments to free flow

Although the tour was guided and narrated, anyone may achieve the desired purpose of the trip by taking a self-guided tour beginning near the Whitestown Shopping Center on NYS Rte. 69 and following the route shown. It is not necessary to leave public rights of way to get a sense of the Basin; although stops for closer inspection/views/photographs will enhance the experience. Please be respectful of private property and do not enter without prior permission.
