RE: ONEIDA COUNTY TITLE VI MOBILITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, Oneida County Executive Anthony J. Picente, Jr. is in receipt of correspondence from the Commissioner of Personnel, Chuck Klein, requesting approval of an amendment to the Personnel Rules of Oneida County to incorporate a Title VI Plan for the 5311 Mobility Management Program in accordance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964; and

WHEREAS, the Title VI Plan for the FTA Section 5311 Mobility Management Program shall be incorporated as an addendum to the Oneida County Title VI Policy set forth in Resolution #275 dated August 26, 2010, and shall include language specific to the administration of the Section 5311 Mobility Management Program consistent with applicable Federal Transit Administration and New York State Department of Transportation Title VI requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Section 5311 Mobility Management Program Title VI Plan shall be made publicly available through the Oneida County Planning Department and Herkimer-Oneida Counties Transportation Council website; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment includes, but is not limited to, provisions prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance, and non-compliance with such requirements may affect eligibility for federal financial assistance, including funding administered through the Federal Transit Administration; and

WHEREAS, said amendment to the Personnel Rules must be approved by the Oneida County Board of Legislators; now, therefore, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the Board of Legislators hereby authorizes and adopts an amendment to the Oneida County Personnel Rules incorporating a 5311 Mobility Management Plan applicable to County officers, employees, and agents responsible for administering or supporting the FTA Section 5311 Mobility Management Program.
