- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee hereby directs the Chairman to communicate this action to the appropriate State and Federal officials in the prescribed manner.

Bylaws of the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee

WHEREAS, it is desirable for the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee of the Herkimer-Oneida Counties Transportation Council and the Herkimer-Oneida Counties Comprehensive Planning Program to be governed by rules for the efficient and proper administration of their affairs,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following Bylaws are hereby adopted by the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee.

Article I

Section 1 Meeting:

Meetings of the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee shall be held at least quarterly, per the standard calendar year beginning on January 1. The meetings may be called by any officer of the Committee, only. Written notice thereof shall be either mailed or emailed to every member of the body, at least one week prior to the scheduled meeting. Meetings of the Committee shall be duly conducted in agreement with the Herkimer-Oneida Counties Transportation Council Public Participation Policy. The Public Participation Policy shall govern requirements for scheduling, moving, or cancelling meetings.

Section 2 Quorum:

At any meeting of the Committee, a quorum shall consist of a majority of the voting members or their officially designated representative. The Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson may designate, at the time of the meeting, a designee from the attendees present, to represent a voting member such that a quorum can be obtained; provided sufficient justification can be made to the Committee Officers that qualifies the designee to represent the absent member. No action shall be taken in the absence of a quorum, except that another meeting can be called for a subsequent date.

Section 3 Voting:

At all meetings of the Committee, each voting member shall be entitled to cast one vote. A majority vote shall be necessary for the adoption or approval of any proposed action, resolution, or other voting matter.

Each voting member may officially designate a representative to attend the meeting and vote on their behalf. The utilization of a designated representative must be communicated to the Secretary or Clerk prior to the meeting being called to order. During roll call, the designated representative will answer in the affirmative and identify which

voting member they are representing.

Section 4 Proceedings:

At any meeting of the Committee, the following shall be the general order of business: Roll Call

- Approval of the Minutes

Public Comment

- Director's Report

- NYSDOT Region 2 Report Other Reports

- Presentations

Old Business

- New Business

- Adjournment

All meetings of the Committee shall be conducted in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order.

Section 5 Rules of Procedure:

All meetings of the Committee shall be open to the general public and allow for public comment at the designated agenda item. Public comments may be received on any agenda item of the same meeting date. Public comment may be provided in written form when received by the Clerk or Secretary by 3:00 p.m. the day preceding the scheduled meeting.

Section 6 Membership

A. Voting Members.

The Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee shall be comprised of nineteen (19) voting members as follows:

Executive, Oneida County

Administrator, Herkimer County

Chairman, Highways Committee, Herkimer County Legislature

Commissioner, Herkimer County Social Services

Chairman, Oneida County Board of Legislators

Majority Leader, Oneida County Board of Legislators

Minority Leader, Oneida County Board of Legislators

Chairman, Public Works Committee, Oneida County Board of Legislators

Mayor, City of Utica

Mayor, City of Rome

Director, Economic Development, Oneida County

Supervisor, Town of Verona

Oneida County Town Supervisor or Village Mayor (max 2 positions) Herkimer County Town Supervisor or Village Mayor (max 1 position) Chairman, Central New York Regional Transportation Authority Regional Director, New York State Department of Transportation Chair, New York State Thruway Authority Board of Directors Executive Director, Herkimer County Industrial Development Agency

The selection of each representative is at the discretion of the signory organizations, where not specified by position. Each member shall be eligible to service during the term as long as the member occupies the position held at the time of selection.

B. Officers:

The officers shall be a Chairperson, a Vice-Chairperson, a Secretary, and a Clerk.

The Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson shall serve in two-year terms and rotate between the chief elected official of Herkimer and Oneida Counties. Leadership will change with the even- numbered years.

The Secretary shall be the Herkimer-Oneida Counties Comprehensive Planning Program Director.

The Clerk shall be the Director of the Herkimer-Oneida Counties Transportation Council or in absence of a director, the Transportation Program Manager of the Herkimer-Oneida Counties Transportation Council will serve in this capacity.

C. Vacancies/Replacement Procedure

If a voting member becomes ineligible or unable to serve, a new member named by the chief elected official or head and/or board of the appropriate governmental unit shall be allowed to nominate a replacement within 30 days of the vacancy and request that nominee be brought to the next full policy committee meeting to be voted on and officially appointed to the committee.

Section 7 Duties of Officers:

A. The Chairperson, shall be charged with the following duties:

1) To preside at meetings.

2) To call meetings in accordance with these Bylaws.

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- 3) To sign, with the Secretary, documents of the Committee in accordance with official actions taken.
- 4) To request HOCTC staff to prepare information on relevant planning topics.
- 5) To carry-out, any additional duties, as assigned by the Committee.
- B. The Vice-Chairperson, shall be charged with the following duties:
 - 1) To serve and conduct all duties of the Chairperson in their absence.
 - 2) To carry-out, any additional duties, as assigned by the Committee.
- C. The Secretary, shall be charged with the following duties:
 - 1) To ensure meetings of the Committee function in accordance with these Bylaws.
 - 2) To ensure all actions taken are recorded properly.
 - 3) To duly sign assurances of correct actions of the Committee.
- D. The Clerk, shall be charged with the following duties:
 - 1) To keep the minutes of the meetings of the Committee.
 - 2) To be a custodian of the records of the Committee.
 - 3) To ensure proper correspondence of all communications of the Committee.
 - 4) To prepare all meeting materials for each agenda of the Committee.
 - Article II

Section 1 Enactment:

- A. These Bylaws may be amended by the majority of the voting members present at any meeting of the Committee. Amendments to these Bylaws shall be made by resolution and considered to be effective as of the close of the same meeting, or by a date otherwise stipulated in the resolution.
- B. The amended Bylaws and copy of the approving resolution shall be provided to every voting member prior to the next scheduled meeting of the Committee.

HOCTC Resolution 2024 – 10

Amendment to the 2024 – 2025 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Budget

- WHEREAS, the Infrastructure & Investment Jobs Act (IIJA) passed November 2021 and prescribed in the FAST Act, the FAST Act authorized the use of funds for Metropolitan Planning Organization's to carry out transportation planning requirements and responsibilities; and
- WHEREAS, Federal regulations (23 CFR Chapter 1, Part 450, Subpart C, and 49 CFR Chapter VI, Part 613, Subpart B) require that the urban transportation planning process shall include development of a Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) which shall annually describe all urban transportation and transportation related planning activities anticipated within the next one year period; and
- WHEREAS, HOCTC developed the 2024 2025 UPWP and budget through the continuous, comprehensive, and cooperative transportation planning process in coordination with state, regional, and local agencies and officials; and
- WHEREAS, the 2024 2025 UPWP was legally advertised for public review in accordance with HOCTC PPP and all applicable regulations; and
- WHEREAS, the 2024 2025 UPWP was approved on February 29, 2024 by HOCTC Resolution 2024 – 02 of the Governmental Policy & Liaison Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the posting of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Federal Fiscal Year 2024 Section 5303 Metropolitan Planning Program (MPP) apportionment, based on the final Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2024 budget, replaces the previously provided 2024/25 Allocations Table; and

- WHEREAS, the allocation for FTA Section 5303 Metropolitan Planning Program (MPP) funds was decreased from \$83,656 to \$81,689 for HOCTC; and
- WHEREAS, the FTA MPP funds programmed are to be decreased in staff work task lines to accurately reflect the carryover balance programmed for 2024 - 2025: and
- WHEREAS, the 2024 2025 UPWP programmed an estimated \$300,000 carryover of FHWA PL funds, where actual expenditures for 2022 - 2023 UPWP resulted in a carryover of \$414,548 in FHWA PL funds; and
- WHEREAS, the FHWA PL funds programmed are to be increased in staff work and contracted services task lines to accurately reflect the carryover balance programmed for 2024 – 2025; and
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the UPWP 2024 2025 budget shall be amended as shown in the attached budget; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Governmental Policy & Liaison Committee authorizes the Transportation Planning Committee to make necessary schedule revisions, project refinements, and give task specific direction to HOCTC staff to carry out this work program during the course of the year; and
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee for HOCTC certifies that the requirements of 23 CFR Part 450.114 (c) have been met; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee approves the amended budget for the 2024 - 2025 UPWP Budget, as shown in the attached tables; and
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Governmental Policy and Liaison Committee hereby directs the Chairperson to communicate this action to the appropriate State and Federal officials in the prescribed manner.

Amendment to the 2023 – 2027 TIP to add a USDOT Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (CFI) Grant Award

WHEREAS, the Governmental Policy & Liaison Committee (GP&L) has previously approved the 2023 – 2027 TIP; and

WHEREAS, a TIP amendment is required when State or Federal Aid funded projects are added to the existing project list; and



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


